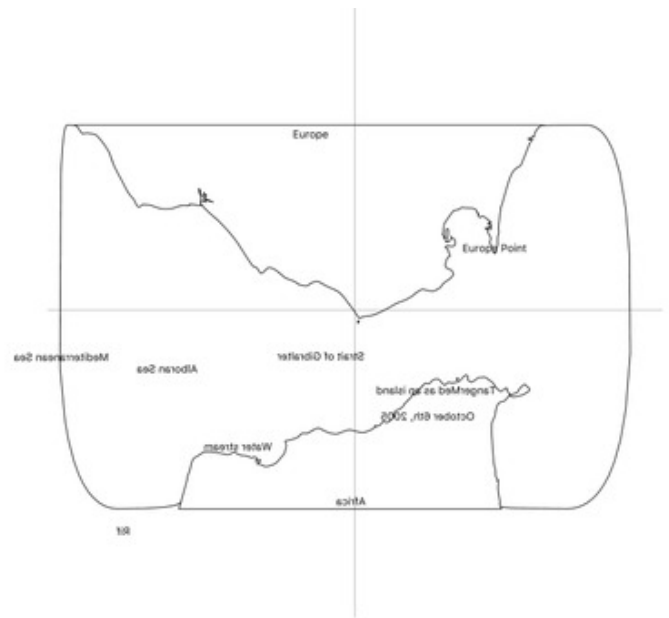
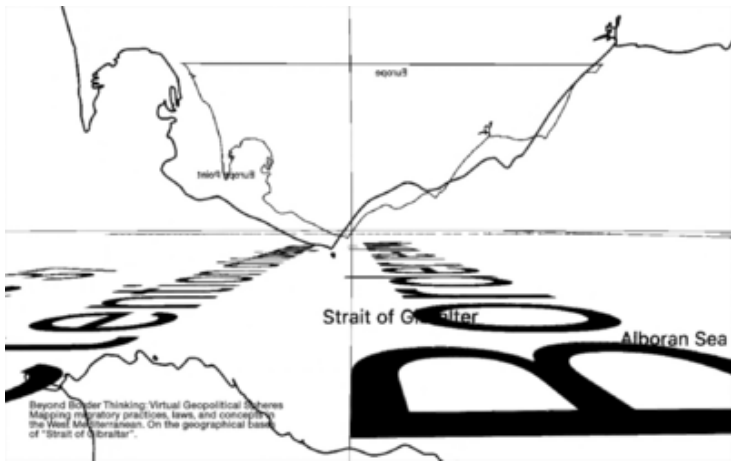
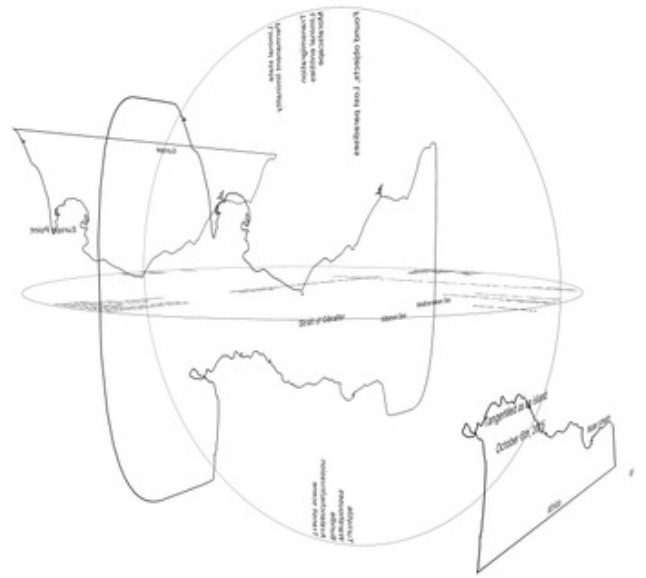
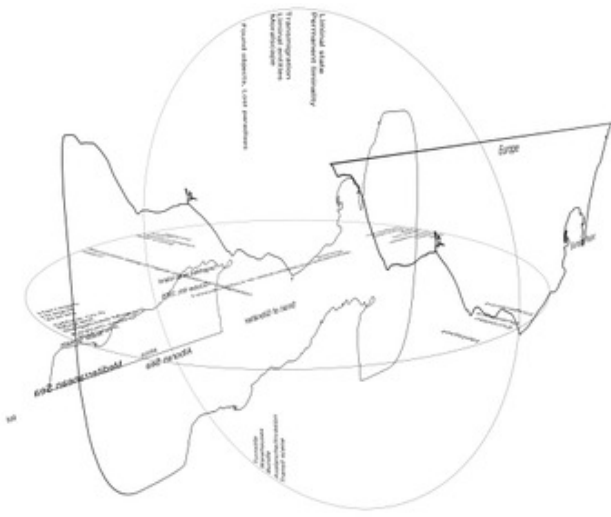
ABSTRACT
